CIT Program WEEKLY FROM JUNE 22 > AUG 14

FOR AGES 14 - 16 YEARS OLD

CITs (Counselors in Training) are assigned to groups or activities as apprentices to the head and senior counselors. Participants develop leadership and interpersonal skills. As part of their training, CITs get a working knowledge of the many activities and program areas offered by Camp Thayer. Each week will be limited to 25 CITs. The application deadline is **March 25**, **2020**. An interview and references are required. Extended Day WEEKLY FROM JUNE 22 > AUG 14

Extended Day options are available for students of all ages in ALL programs and are supervised by a head counselor who is assisted by senior and junior counselors. Activities may include arts & crafts, board games, computers, recreational swimming, and four square.

Get individualized attention for goalies to develop skills beyond stopping the ball.

Girls lacrosse camp is offered to players of all levels for girls in grades 3-8. Athletes will be evaluated and grouped based on skill level and have fun competing in our infamous "Final Four Tournament" while improving their fundamental skill level, "lacrosse IQ," fitness, and (most importantly) individual confidence. Robotics Camp

WEEK 5 | July 20-24 WEEK 6 | July 27-31

GRADES 5-8, CO-ED

Limited to 15 kids

Through a series of hands-on activities and games, campers will explore the fundamentals of robotics and engineering, lead by Thayer Academy science teacher Adam Pearson. Using VEX IQ kits in a state of the art high school robotics lab, we will start by examining the basic building blocks of any device, known as simple machines. We will then work our way through constructing and programming robots with multiple types of sensors. By the end of the week, campers will have engaged in building, programming, and problem solving through the exciting lens of robotics.

Cost: \$500/week.






Daytrippers week 7 | August 3-7 AGES 9-12, CO-ED



A wide range of varied trips is in store for Camp Thayer Daytrippers! Daytripper sessions may include fun times at Water Wizz, a Paw Sox baseball game, whale watching, a tour of Fenway Park, exploring the Harbor Islands, a trip to the New England Aquarium, Nantasket Beach, mini golf, a visit to an amusement park, and/or other exciting activities including sailing, rollerblading, and kayaking. NOTE: Some trips require early departure and/or a late return.

Cost: \$500/week.

Directed by Thayer Upper School Arts faculty Kelly Hines and Dan Alosa, each production is custom-written and musically arranged to feature all students in their best light and create a meaningful collaborative ensemble theatre experience. Students receive professional instruction in all foundational aspects of theatre arts singing, dance, acting, and basic stagecraft. Large casts offer mentorship and support, and every student finds their moment to shine.

All registrations are to be done online - and spaces (particularly for specialty and limited enrollment camps) are given on a first-come, first-served basis in the order they are received (there is a new online waitlist section). Medical forms are also filled out online (with immunization records needing to be sent by your child's physician). There is a \$200 deposit/camper which is paid online with a credit card. This deposit will be applied to your Camp balance. You will receive an email confirmation upon completion of your online registration. Full payment is due prior to the start of your first session.

Once your registration has been processed, any reduction or cancellation of enrollment will cause the deposit to be forfeited. **After June 8, 2020**, no part of the tuition will be canceled or refunded in the event of any absence, withdrawal, or dismissal from the program. This applies to all camp programs, including Extended Day and transportation. However, you may sign up for our Tuition Refund Plan (TRP) at a cost of \$10 per camper per week. The plan pays part of the unused tuition for the number of consecutive days missed, if that number is greater than four. Tuition will be reimbursed as follows:

- ▶ Medical absence or withdrawal (requires a physician's note) = 75%
- Non-medical (voluntary) withdrawal = 60%
- Dismissal = 60%

To request a refund from the plan, you must apply in writing to the Camp Office, indicating the days missed and the reason for your child's absence. Since most families do opt for the TRP, the cost of coverage will be added to your bill. You may elect to waive it by signing and returning the waiver form with your payment (minus the cost of the plan premium). Your account will be credited accordingly.

Immunization Records

Physician-signed immunization records are needed for all campers.
