You have two options for the college essay writing workshops that Thayer is offering. This is a great way to get a head start on your applications.

OPTION 1 The College Essay Guy,

Ethan Sawyer Workshop

June 1 - 5

Meets Monday, Wednesday, and Friday with live sessions held from 1:00 - 2:30 p.m. or 7:00 - 8:30 p.m.

During the week, you will be connected with a Thayer English teacher or college counselor who will help provide feedback on your essay topic, and later you can meet with that person for a 10-minute session to review your first draft.

OPTION 2

Traditional Thayer Academy Workshop June 22 from 1:00 - 2:30 p.m.

The Thayer Academy college counselors and English teachers will host one of our traditional essay workshops. After topic approval, you will write a rough draft on your own, and then on June 29 you will meet one-on-one with one of the teachers or college counselors to receive feedback on your draft.
