

#### When does school start?

Students should be with their advisors by 8 a.m. and remain on campus through that day's final bell. Students arriving after 8:05 a.m. must report to Mr. Murphy in the Student Commons and get a pass to enter the classroom.

#### What's the absence/tardiness/dismissal policy?

Parents of students who will be absent, tardy, or dismissed early must call the office at **781.843.3580**. Students arriving late or leaving early must present a note of explanation, signed by a parent or guardian, to Mr. Murphy in the Student Commons as soon as they get to school. In emergency situations, parents may call the office and provide a note the next day. In order to participate in any extracurricular activity, a student must be in class by 8:15 a.m. and attend classes for the entire day. Thayer Academy has two registered nurses on staff, and students should consult them if feeling ill. Parents will be called if a nurse determines the student should go home. Students should not contact parents directly to request dismissal from school.

#### What should students wear?

Thayer Academy has just updated its dress code, which is now an all-school policy (i.e., not US or MS-specific). As always, the purpose of the dress code is to reflect respect for the discipline and seriousness of academic pursuits. #### Which students can get parking permits?

Parking permits are distributed at the beginning of the school year to student drivers in the junior and senior classes only. Students who drive to school must complete a Parking Permit Application to be signed by the student and a parent or guardian. Cars that do not display a current Thayer parking permit or that are parked in violation of the rules are subject to towing or loss of parking privileges.

#### How do I know if school is cancelled?

Thayer uses an automated service to contact families in case of a school-wide emergency or closing due to weather. Phone calls, text messages, and emails are sent out, and information is posted on the website as well provided to local TV and radio stations. #### Where can I park for athletic events?

On particularly busy days, parking may be at a premium. Please try to park in the Middle School, Glover, or CFA parking lots if at all possible. There is no parking available at the Braintree Town Hall parking lot or along Hobart Avenue. If the lots are filled and you must park on a side street near the track (Tremont), please do not block any private or public driveways.

## What is the Safe Homes program?
